Last month's minutes approved/second by Melissa Rachinsky-Eckelman

Informative meeting with Mr. Altobello and Ken Walls (Director of Health and Safety for District) regarding the modular which houses our 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, and 3<sup>rd</sup> grades.

Key points:

- 1.) What is the damage that has been addressed?
- 2.) Long term plans?

With the damage done in Burcz classroom:

- Students removed from that classroom and placed in APR
- Damaged area removed/repared/replaced
- Air-quality control test done prior to going back into the classroom
- Only her class was notified because only her class was affected
- All vents on roof have been replaced

Ken Walls informed all that there is no standards for mold, only recommendations. Tests performed are for air-quality (with CO2 being tested, as well as humidity levels which would show wetness). This modular is here since 2005 and was a used modular (3 years old when we got it), The modular is 15 years old so District is looking into all options for replacement/solutions.

Life expectancy is coming up so the district knows something must be done.

Currently, the district will send in someone to monitor those levels once/month.

Mr. Altobello has offered to invite the Superintendent, Dr. George to a PTA informational meeting to discuss ALL our concerns.
